

The Clearfield County Commissioners have contracted with Mission Critical Partners, LLC, to develop a broadband internet strategic plan for the County to determine the level of broadband service across the entire County, and to develop a roadmap for ensuring that areas currently unserved or underserved have access to affordable and reliable high-speed broadband. The Commissioners recognize that access to high-speed broadband services is critical for education, economic development, healthcare, and many other facets of life today and want to ensure that all County residents and businesses have adequate broadband services. To accomplish this, Mission Critical Partners staff will be reaching out to County stakeholders, including school districts, healthcare providers, businesses, residents, and others to gather information about the current state of broadband services across the County to identify those areas most in need of improved service. An online survey will also be developed, which can be accessed via the County's website at: <https://clearfieldco.org> . All permanent residents, seasonal residents, business operators, educational institutions, healthcare providers, and any other stakeholders are encouraged to access and complete the survey, which will only take about 10-15 minutes to complete, so we are able to have the most accurate information possible for this planning effort. For people who are unable to access the on-line survey, there will also be additional meetings scheduled to collect information, with the dates, times, and locations to be announced in the future.
