Elect 2 per voting precinct.

- The office of Inspector of Election appears on the Municipal Primary and Election ballots as "VOTE FOR ONE". Then, in the Municipal Election, the candidate receiving the highest number of votes for Inspector is elected "Majority Inspector of Election". The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes for Inspector is elected "Minority Inspector of Election".
