

The regular meeting of the Clearfield County Commissioners was held on Tuesday, August 24, 2021 with Chair Sobel conducting the meeting. The following were in attendance: Commissioners Scotto and Glass; Heather Bozovich, Solicitor; Tom Adamson, Controller; Lisa Kovalick, Executive Director CCRA; Mike Armanini, State Representative; Jeff Corcino, Progress/Courier; Jessica Shirey, gantdaily.com; Yanni Tragellis, WTAJTV; Lisa McFadden, Chief Clerk,

Minutes of the August 10, 2021 meeting were approved by motion of Commissioner Glass, seconded by Commissioner Scotto; motion carried unanimously.

Controller Adamson presented the following bills for approval: General Fund, \$2,061,406.22; Liquid Fuels fund, \$7,015.98; Operating Reserve, \$99.95; Hazardous materials Fund, \$98.69; 911 Fund, \$377,906.26; Communities Development Block Grant, \$142,260.75; Domestic Relations, \$41,332.14; Children Youth Services Fund, \$492,699.28. Approval by motion of Commissioner Scotto, seconded by Commissioner Glass; motion carried unanimously.

New Business

Lisa Kovalick attended the meeting to ask the Board to consider adoption of Resolution 2021-#3 for DCED HOME Application and Housing Rehabilitation Grant. Ms. Kovalick explained that through the Clearfield County Redevelopment Authority she would be applying for \$286,277 to assist in rehabbing blighted properties throughout the County. Homeowners may apply for the funds and must live in the home and all taxes must be paid to date. Motion to adopt Resolution 2021-#3 and execute the assurance of compliance by Commissioner Glass, seconded by Commissioner Scotto; motion carried unanimously.

Chair Sobel asked for a motion to approve an Agreement with PA Dept. of Agriculture for the Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP). The agreement is for the period of October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2026 with program administration by Central PA Community Action. Motion to execute the agreement by Commissioner Scotto, seconded by Commissioner Glass; motion carried unanimously. (Chief Clerk McFadden questioned the need for a Sub-Recipient agreement and will contact CPCAA for an answer)

Liquid Fuel allocation for Mahaffey Borough in the amount of \$3,000 by motion of Commissioner Glass, seconded by Commissioner Scotto; Commissioner Sobel abstained due to conflict, motion carried.

Commissioner Sobel spoke about the current situation with Afghanistan and if any Veterans are in need of counseling or resources to please contact the DuBois VA Clinic or the County VA office to put you in touch with assistance.

Solicitors Report - Solicitor Bozovich reported that the loan with Huntingdon Bank has been approved and the energy savings project should be able to move forward soon.

Motion to adjourn by Commissioner Glass, seconded by Commissioner Scotto; motion carried unanimously.
