

The regular meeting of the Clearfield County Commissioners was held on Tuesday, February 9, 2021 with Chair Sobel conducting the meeting. The following were in attendance: Commissioners Scotto and Glass; Heather Bozovich, Solicitor; Tom Adamson, Controller; Jessica Shirey, gantdaily.com; Jeff Corcino, Progress/Courier; Yvonne Lehmann, Radio WOKW; Justin Jarrett, IT; Lisa McFadden, Chief Clerk.

Minutes of the previous meeting of January 26, 2020 were approved by motion of Commissioner Glass, seconded by Commissioner Scotto; motion carried unanimously.

Controller Adamson presented the following bills for approval: General Fund, \$32,031.13; Hazardous Materials Fund, \$449.69; 911 Fund, \$380,104.09; Hotel Tax Fund, \$69,794.33; Community Development Block Grant, \$16,935.55; Domestic Relations, \$291,288.14; Children Youth Services, \$480,213.39. Motion to approve the bills by Commissioner Glass, seconded by Commissioner Scotto; motion carried unanimously.

New Business

Chair Sobel called for a motion to Proclaim February 20, 2021 as Hoodie Hoo Day in Clearfield County. Approval by motion of Commissioner Scotto, seconded by Commissioner Glass; motion carried unanimously.

Chair Sobel presented an agreement with Cen-Clear Child Services to provide psychiatric services for the County Jail. Do to the COVID restrictions there have been increased cases of mental illness in the County Prison. Cen-clear will provide the service either in person or via telehealth at a cost of \$250/hour not to exceed 10 hours. Approval by motion of Commissioner Glass, seconded by Commissioner Scotto; motion carried unanimously.

Chair Sobel presented an agreement with Viking Water Technology. Chief Clerk McFadden explained that Viking oversees, tests and provides the chemicals for the operation of the boiler in the Courthouse. The agreement is a one year term from May 1, 2021 to April 30, 2022 at a cost of \$2,484. Motion to execute the agreement by Commissioner Scotto, seconded by Commissioner Glass; motion carried unanimously.

Solicitors Report -

Solicitor Bozovich reported that she received additional feedback from CCAP with respect to the STEB issue and has forwarded the information to Lisa Conrad for review and response.
