

The regular meeting of the Clearfield County Commissioners was held on Tuesday, January 12, 2021 with Chair Sobel conducting the meeting. The following were in attendance Commissioners Scotto and Glass; Marianne Sankey, Human Resources Director; Heather Bozovich, Solicitor; Adam Curry, IT Director; Jessica Shirey, gantdaily.com; Yvonne Lehmann, Radio WOKW; Jeff Corcino, Progress/Courier; Lisa McFadden, Chief Clerk.

Minutes of the previous meeting of January 5, 2021 were not available for approval due to a computer incident that affected all County Computers. The minutes will be approved at the next Commissioners meeting.

Controller Adamson presented the following bills for approval: General Fund, \$1,127,476.86; Liquid Fuels Fund, \$9,589.23; Domestic Relations Fund, \$40.00; Children Youth Services Fund, \$111,576.88. Approval of the bills by Commissioner Scotto, seconded by Commissioner Glass; motion carried unanimously.

Chair Sobel read a prepared statement concerning the computer issues that affected the

“Clearfield County recently detected and is responding to malware activity on our computer network. As soon as we learned this, we began working to investigate, to restore operations, and determine the effects of the incident. We also are working with nationally recognized third-party cybersecurity consultants to assist us. At this time, there is no evidence that our information has been compromised. We continue to actively monitor the situation.

All essential services continue to operate, including 9-1-1 operations and emergency communications.

The safety and security of the public and County employees remains our top priority. We are working around the clock to work through this cyber incident and ask for the public’s patience as we implement business continuity measures.

We will be able to provide updates as our investigation proceeds.”

The Commissioners thanked Adam Curry and Justin Jarrett of the County IT Department and also Commissioner Glass for the work they have done so far in getting the computers back up and running.

Chair Sobel opened the Prison Energy Project RFQ's. The following companies submitted proposals for the project. ABM Building Solutions, Constellations Energy, McClure Company, Brewer Garrett. The proposals will be reviewed and a decision will be made at a later date. No action taken.
